DEPENDENT RESURVEY OF THE EAST BOUNDARY OF T. 37 N.,  
R. 42 E., MOUNT DIABLO MERIDIAN, NEVADA

Re-establishment of the Survey Executed by A. J.  
Hatch, Deputy Surveyor, in 1868

Beginning at the cor. of Tps. 36 and 37 N., Rs. 42 and  
43 E., monumented with an iron post, 2½ ins. diam., set,  
mkd. and witnessed as described in the field notes of the  
concurrent resurvey of T. 36 N., R. 42 E.

N. 0° 34' W., bet. secs. 31 and 36.

Over nearly level land, through medium undergrowth.

34.40 Creek, 30 lks. wide, 3 ft. deep, course SW.

40.22 Point for the ¼ sec. cor. of secs. 31 and 36, at propor-  
tionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of the  
original corner.

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 22 ins. in  
the ground, with brass cap mkd.

47.70 Small stream, course W.

71.90 Trail road, bears N. 60° E. and S. 60° W.

80.44 Point for the cor. of secs. 25, 30, 31 and 36, at propor-  
tionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of the  
original corner.

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 22 ins. in  
the ground, with brass cap mkd.

Soil, sandy, clay and alkaline.

Undergrowth, greasewood and shadscale.

40.22 Over nearly level land, through medium undergrowth.  
The ¼ sec. cor. of secs. 25 and 30, monumented with a  
squared wooden post, 1x1x34 ins. long, dimly mkd. and  
loosely set in a mound of earth.
