33.60 Ravine, drains NW.; desc. 130 ft. over a NW. slope.

39.00 Ravine, drains N. 60° W.; asc. 20 ft. along a W. slope.

41.01 Point for the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of secs. 1 and 6, at proportionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner.

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 14 ins. in the ground to bedrock and in a mound of stone to cap, 3½ ft. base, with brass cap mkd.
