The point for the closing corner of Tps. 38 and 39 N.,
R. 42 E., is at the intersection of the continuation of the
line bet. secs. 1 and 36 and the W. bdy. of T. 38 N.,
R. 43 E.

At the corner point

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 22 ins. in
the ground, with brass cap mkd.

raise a mound of stone, 2½ ft. base, 2 ft. high, W. of cor.

From this corner, the corner of Tps. 38 and 39 N., R. 43 E.
which is an iron post, 2½ ins. diam., set, mkd. and wit-
nessed as described in the field notes of the resurvey of
T. 38 N., R. 43 E., bears N. 0° 52' E., 18.98 chs. dist.

From the closing cor. of Tps. 38 and 39 N., R. 42 E.

S. 89° 01' W., bet. secs. 1 and 36.
