<p>GENERAL DESCRIPTION</p>		
<p>A considerable variety of land and soil are found in Township 38 North, Range 42 East. The elevation ranges from about 4,600 ft. to 8,350 ft. above sea level. The western portion of the township is mountainous, the central and northeastern portion rolling and the southeastern portion gently rolling to nearly level. The soil varies from sandy loam on the lower elevations to sandy clay loam, gravelly and rocky on the mountains. The timber is composed of aspen along the creeks. The vegetation consists of sagebrush, budsage, shadscale and sparse native grasses.</p> <p>The summit of the Osgood Mountains extends through secs. 6, 7 and 18. Portions of secs. 6, 7 and 18 drains westerly. The remainder of the township is drained southeasterly by numerous small creeks and dry washes.</p> <p>There has been considerable mining activity for gold, silver and tungsten in the western portion of the township. Other users of the area are cattlemen.</p> <p>Access into the township is provided by a graded gravel road, bearing northerly through the township to Getchell Mines, Inc., located in sec. 33, T. 39 N., R. 42 E. and numerous other improved and unimproved roads.</p>
