N. 89° 48' W., bet. secs. 36 and 36.

Over gently rolling land, through medium undergrowth.

39.98 Point for the ¼ sec. cor. of secs. 36 and 36, at proportionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner.

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.
