CHAINS

N. 0° 28' E., bet secs. 7 and 12.
 Asc. 80 ft. over gentle S. slope.

40.28 The ¼ sec. cor. of secs. 7 and 12, monumented with a lava stone, 8x6x5 ins., plainly mkd. and firmly set.

At the corner point

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 20 ins. in the ground and in a collar of stone, with brass cap mkd.

40.15 The cor. of secs. 1, 6, 7 and 12, monumented with a granite stone, 18x12x10 ins., plainly mkd. and embedded in a circle of stones.

At the corner point

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 14 ins. in the ground and in a mound of stone, 3½ ft. base to top, with brass cap mkd.
