

DEPENDENT RESURVEY OF A PORTION OF THE S. BDY., T. 8 N., R. 42 E.

CHAINS

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 22 ins. in the ground with brass cap mkd.

Land, low, rolling.  
Soil, stony, mixed with sandy clay.  
Undergrowth, scrub sage and salt brush.

N. 89° 41' W., bet. secs. 5 and 32.

Over gentle rolling land, covered with scrub sage and salt brush.

28.30 Wash, 25 lks. wide, 2 ft. deep, drains S. 15° W.

40.28 Point for the ¼ sec. cor. of secs. 5 and 32, at proportionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner.

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 22 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.
