CHAINS

Set an iron post, 36 ins. long, 1 in. diam., 6 ins. in the ground and in a mound of stone, 4 ft. base to top, with brass cap mkd.

54.10 Wash, 30 lks. wide, 12 ins. deep, drains S.; asc. 90 ft. over a steep E. slope.

58.80 Narrow ridge, bears N. and S.; desc. 200 ft. over a W. slope.

68.80 Draw, drains S. 20° E.; asc. 60 ft. over an E. slope.

72.50 Top of ridge, bears N. and S., line on N. edge of limestone outcropping; desc. 110 ft. over a W. slope.

80.00 Point for the cor. of secs. 4, 5, 32 and 33, at record distance.

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 10 ins. in the ground and in a mound of stone, 3½ ft. base to top, with brass cap mkd.
