

## TOWNSHIP 19 NORTH, RANGE 63 EAST

CHAINS

The geographic position of the cor. of secs. 2, 3, 34 and 35 Tps. 18 and 19 N., R. 63 E. is latitude  $39^{\circ} 27' 48.929''$  N. and longitude  $114^{\circ} 51' 37.277''$  W. a B.L.M. tellurometer station, under Group 389, Nevada.

The magnetic declination was read at a number of stations throughout the township and the average of these readings was found to be  $17^{\circ}$  east.

## DEPENDENT RESURVEY OF THE EAST BDY OF T. 19 N., R. 63 E.

Reestablishment of the Survey Executed  
by Bateman and Monroe, Deputy  
Surveyors in 1872

Beginning the dependent resurvey of the E. bdy., T. 19 N., R. 63 E. at the cor. of Tps. 18 and 19 N., Rs. 63 and 64 E.

Point for the cor. of Tps. 18 and 19 N., Rs. 63 and 64 E. at proportionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner.

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long,  $2\frac{1}{2}$  ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.

The  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor. of secs. 3 and 34, Tps. 18 and 19 N., R. 64 E., monumented with a porphyry stone, 12x10x8 ins., firmly set, marked and witnessed as described in the official record; bears S.  $89^{\circ} 47'$  E., 275.59 chs. dist.

At the corner point

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long,  $2\frac{1}{2}$  ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground with brass cap mkd.
