CHAINS

Land, nearly level.
Soil, sandy and gravelly alkaline clay loam.
Timber, none; undergrowth, sagebrush and rabbit brush.

N. 0° 05' W., bet. secs. 1 and 6.

Over nearly level land, through heavy undergrowth.

39.96 Point for the 1/4 sec. cor. of secs. 1 and 6, at proportionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner.

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2 1/2 ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.
