This corner now becomes an angle point on the east bdy. of sec. 12.</p> <p>At the corner point</p> <p>Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 10 ins. in the ground to bedrock and in a collar of stone, with brass cap mkd.</p> <p style="text-align: center;"> T19N R43E R44E AP S 12 S 6 </p> <p style="text-align: center;">1964</p> <p>reset the remains of wooden post and granite stone alongside the iron post.</p> <p>Land, rolling W. slope. Soil, sandy loam and rocky. Vegetation, sagebrush and sparse native grasses. Timber, scattered pinon pine and juniper.</p>
<p>1.40</p> <p>4.00</p>	<p>N. 0° 29' E., bet. secs. 6 and 12.</p> <p>Over gently rolling terrain, draining W., through dense low brush.</p> <p>The closing sec. cor. of secs. 1 and 12, hereinafter described.</p> <p>Thence bet. secs. 1 and 6.</p> <p>Small wash, drains W.; asc. 40 ft. over S. slope.</p>
