Reestablishment of a portion of the survey executed by

From the cor. of secs. 1, 2, 35 and 36, on the S. bdy of
the Tp.

N. 0° 11' W., bet. secs. 35 and 36.

Desc. 80 ft. along gentle rolling W. slope, through
scattered timber.

20.40 Bladed road, bears NNE. and SSW.; leave scattered timber;
over gently rolling land.

39.97 Point for the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of secs. 35 and 36, at propor-
tionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of the
original corner.

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, $2\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., 22 ins. in
the ground, with brass cap mkd.

44.80 Track road, bears NE. and SW.

53.80 Small wash, drains NW.

74.40 Wash, 10 lks. wide, 2 ft. deep, drains W.

79.00 Small spur, slopes W.

79.94 The cor. of secs. 25, 26, 35 and 36, monumented with a
granite stone, 20x14x10 ins., firmly set and plainly mkd.
as described in the official records.

At the corner point

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, $2\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., 20 ins. in
the ground and in a collar of stone, with brass cap mkd.
