CHAINS

N. 3° 27' E., bet. secs. 1 and 6.

Over rolling land covered with sage and salt brush.

Ascend 40 ft. over a gradual SE. slope.

39.44 Point for the 1/4 sec. cor. of secs. 1 and 6, at proportionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner.

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2 1/2 ins. diam., 20 ins. in the ground and in a collar of stone, with brass cap mkd.
