

DEPENDENT RESURVEY, W. BDY., T. 15 N., R. 38 E.

CHAINS

N. 11° 08' E., bet. secs. 1 and 6.

Over mountainous land covered with medium dense pinon and juniper.

Descend 50 ft. over a NW. slope.

4.00 Head of draw, drains NW.; asc. 60 ft. over a SW. slope.

12.80 Spur, slopes NW.; desc. 270 ft. over a broken N. slope.

26.60 Draw, drains NW.; asc. 40 ft. over a broken S. slope.

32.90 Spur, slopes W.; desc. 200 ft. over a N. slope.

39.34 Point for the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of secs. 1 and 6, at proportionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner.

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, $2\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., 14 ins. in the ground and in a mound of stone, $3\frac{1}{2}$ ft. base to top, with brass cap mkd.

48.50 Bottom of draw, drains NW.; asc. 250 ft. over a broken S. slope.

61.00 Spur, slopes W.; desc. 250 ft. over a broken NW. slope.

74.70 Wash in bottom of Buffalo Canyon, drains SW.

78.39 Intersect the Third Standard Parallel North.

Point for the closing cor. of T. 15 N., Rs. 37 and 38 E., at proportionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner.

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, $2\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., 20 ins. in the ground and in a collar of stone, with brass cap mkd.
