GENERAL DESCRIPTION

Township 15 North, Range 38 East, is located at the head of Smith Creek Valley with the northwest portion extending into the Desatoya Mountains to Buffalo Canyon. The general elevation ranges from about 6,100 ft. to about 7,500 ft. above sea level. The soil is a mixture of sand and clay loam., the west and north portions being in the mountains is somewhat stony.

There are a number of improved dirt roads that traverse throughout the township, the principle one of these is the Austin and Gold Park road which enters the township on the east boundary near the cor. of secs. 7, 12, 13 and 18, traversing through the township and leaving on the south boundary near the cor. of secs. 5, 6, 31 and 32.
