

## SURVEY OF THE WEST BDY., T. 17 N., R. 39 E.

## CHAINS

Land, mountainous.  
Soil, sandy loam and rocky.  
Timber, pinon pine and juniper.  
Undergrowth, sagebrush and sparse native grasses.

NORTH, bet. secs. 1 and 6.

Over rolling, mountainous terrain; through scattered timber.

Ascend 10 ft. along E. slope.

21.10 Crest of ascent; desc. 210 ft. along an E. slope.

40.00 Point for the  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor. of secs. 1 and 6.

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long,  $2\frac{1}{2}$  ins. diam., 10 ins. in the ground to bedrock and in a mound of stone,  $3\frac{1}{2}$  ft. base to top, with brass cap mkd.

A juniper, 6 ins. diam., bears N.  $85^\circ$  E., 0.39 chs. dist., mkd.  $\frac{1}{4}$  S 6 BT.

A juniper, 12 ins. diam., bears N.  $60^\circ$  W., 0.37 chs. dist., mkd.  $\frac{1}{4}$  S 1 BT.

Ascend 20 ft. over a SE. slope.

43.30 Ridge, bears NNE. and SSW.; desc. 260 ft. over a W. slope.

75.24 Intersect the S. bdy. of T. 18 N., R. 39 E.

Point for the closing cor. of Tp. 17 N., Rs. 38 and 39 E.

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long,  $2\frac{1}{2}$  ins. diam., 10 ins. in the ground to bedrock and in a mound of stone,  $3\frac{1}{2}$  ft. base to top, with brass cap mkd.
