	Descend 40 ft. over a rocky N. slope.
40.00	Point for the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of sec. 5. Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, $2\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., 5 ins. in the ground to bedrock and in a mound of stone, $3\frac{1}{2}$ ft. base to top, with brass cap mkd. <div style="text-align: center;"> T17N R39E $\frac{1}{4}$ S 5 1964 </div>
	Descend 130 ft. over a N. slope.
44.70	Small wash, drains NW.; desc. 150 ft. over a N. slope.
74.80	Bladed dirt road, bears WNW. and ESE.; desc. 10 ft. over a N. slope.
78.36	Intersect the S. bdy. of T. 18 N., R. 39 E. Point for the closing cor. of secs. 4 and 5. Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, $2\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., 22 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd. <div style="text-align: center;"> T18N R39E S 33 S 5 S 4 CC T17N 1964 </div>

Soil, sandy clay and rocky. Timber, scattered juniper and pinon pine in last half mile. Undergrowth, sagebrush and sparse native grasses.</p>
	Point for the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of sec. 5, on the N. bdy. of the Tp., at midpoint bet. the closing cors of secs. 5 and 6, and secs. 4 and 5. Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, $2\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., 18 ins. in the ground and in a collar of stone, with brass cap mkd. <div style="text-align: center;"> T18N R39E $\frac{1}{4}$ S 5 T17N 1964 </div>
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
