23.40 Trail road, bears WNW. and ESE.

32.80 Spur, slopes SW.; desc. 80 ft. over a NW. slope.

40.21 Point for the 1/4 sec. cor. of secs. 31 and 36, at proportionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner.

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2 1/2 ins. diam., 8 ins. in the ground to bedrock and in a mound of stone, 4 ft. base to top, with brass cap mkd.
