

Dependent Resurvey of the Subdivisional Lines, T. 27 N., R. 62 E.

CHAINS

GENERAL DESCRIPTION

The township is located in Butte Valley, about 20 miles west of Currie, Nevada.

The land varies from a rolling valley to the rough Cherry Creek mountain range.

The soil is mostly a clay loam, very rocky in the mountainous portion.

The timber consists of scrub juniper and pinon with mountain mahogany and a few ponderosa pine in the mountains.

There is considerable vegetation through out the township, providing grazing for cattle and sheep.

The water is supplied from numerous springs throughout the valley.

No minerals were noted during the course of the survey. There are no settlements in the township.
