Soil, sandy clay loam. Undergrowth, sagebrush, greasewood, rabbitbrush and bunchgrass.</p>

	<p>From the cor. of secs. 27, 28, 33 and 34.</p> <p>S. 89° 58' W., bet. secs. 28 and 33.</p> <p>Over nearly level land through medium dense undergrowth.</p>
