

NORTH BOUNDARY OF T. 18 N., R. 47 E.

CHAINS

Land, nearly level.
Soil, sandy clay to light gravel.
Undergrowth, sagebrush.

WEST, bet. secs. 6 and 7.

Over high rolling land, covered with sage and bunch grass.

1.00 Enter reseeding area, bears N. and S.; asc. 80 ft. over an E. slope.

16.00 Leave reseeding area at base of hills; asc. 200 ft. over a steep E. slope.

29.10 Spur, slopes SE.; desc. 30 ft. along a S. slope.

34.20 Draw, drains SE.; asc. 100 ft. over an E. slope.

40.00 Point for the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of secs. 6 and 7.

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, $2\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., 18 ins. in the ground, and in a collar of stone, with brass cap mkd.

Asc. 340 ft. over a broken, steep E. slope.

73.94 Intersect the east bdy. of T. 18 N., R. 46 E.

Point for the closing corner of Tps. 18 and 18 $\frac{1}{2}$ N., R. 47 E.

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, $2\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., 10 ins. in the ground, and in a mound of stone, 4 ft. base to top, with brass cap mkd.
