Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 6 ins. in the ground, and in a mound of stone, 3½ ft. base to top, with brass cap mkd.

62.60 Top of ridge, bears N. and S.; desc. 160 ft. over a NW. slope.

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 18 ins. in the ground, and in a collar of stone, with brass cap mkd.
