GENERAL DESCRIPTION

The land within Township 18 North, Range 47 East, is rolling and mountainous. The eastern and western portion is mountainous. The elevation ranges from about 6,300 to 7,100 ft. above sea level. The soil varies from sandy clay loam on the lower elevations to gravelly and rocky on the mountains. The timber is composed of scattered pinon and juniper on the higher elevations. The vegetation consists of sagebrush, shadscale, budsage and crested wheat grass.

The township is drained by Stoneberger Creek in Monitor Valley located in the central portion of the township. No mineral formations of consequence were noted during the survey.

Principal users of the area are cattlemen and the access into the township is provided by desert roads.
