Asc. 40 ft. over a gentle E. slope.

80.00 Point for the cor. of secs. 5, 6, 31 and 32.

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, $2\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., 20 ins. in the ground, and in a collar of stone, with brass cap mkd.

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, $2\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., 8 ins. in the ground, and in a mound of stone, 4 ft. base to top, with brass cap mkd.
