At the corner point

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2 1/2 ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.

SURVEY OF SUBDIVISIONAL LINES OF
T. 21 N., R. 49 E., MDM., NEVADA

The meridional section lines were run parallel to the mean course of the east bdy. to a closing on the north bdy. which is defective in position.

Beginning at the standard corner of secs. 35 and 36, on the S. bdy. of the Tp., monumented with an iron post, 3 ins. diam., set, mkd. and witnessed as described in the field notes of the survey of Fourth Standard Parallel North through Range 49 East.

N. 0° 03' W., bet. secs. 35 and 36.

Over nearly level land, through medium undergrowth.
