CHAINS

N. 0° 03' W., bet. secs. 2 and 3.

Over nearly level land, through medium undergrowth.

35.20 Coils Creek, 1.00 chain wide, 2 ft. deep, drains SSE.

40.00 Point for the 1/4 sec. cor. of secs. 2 and 3.

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2 1/2 ins. diam., 22 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.

Point for the closing corner of secs. 2 and 3.

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2 1/2 ins. diam., 20 ins. in the ground and in a collar of stone, with brass cap mkd.

Land, nearly level.
Soil, sandy clay and light gravel.
Undergrowth, sagebrush.

Point for the N 1/4 sec. cor. of sec. 2, is at midpoint and on the N. bdy. of the Tp.

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2 1/2 ins. diam., 20 ins. in the ground and in a collar of stone, with brass cap mkd.

From the standard corner of secs. 33 and 34 on the S. bdy. of the Tp., monumented with an iron post, 3 ins. diam., set, mkd. and witnessed as described in the field notes of the survey of the Fourth Standard Parallel North, through Range 49 East.
