Land, nearly level.

Soil, sandy clay and light gravel.

Undergrowth, sagebrush.

Point for the N. $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of sec. 3, is at midpoint and on the N. bdy. of the Tp.

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, $2\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., 22 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.

From the standard corner of secs. 32 and 33 on the S. bdy. of the Tp., monumented with an iron post, 3 ins. diam., set, mkd. and witnessed as described in the field notes of the survey of the Fourth Standard Parallel North, through Range 49 East.
