61.20 Wash, 10 lks. wide, 2 ft. deep, drains S.

79.98 The cor. of secs. 4, 5, 8 and 9.

Land, gentle rolling.
Soil, sandy clay and light gravel.
Undergrowth, sagebrush.

N. 0° 05' W., bet. secs. 4 and 5.

Over gentle rolling land, through medium undergrowth.

40.00 Point for the 1/4 sec. cor. of secs. 4 and 5.

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2 1/2 ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground and in a collar of stone, with brass cap mkd.
