Asc. 20 ft. over an E. slope.

42.50 Spur, slopes SE.; desc. 150 ft. over a broken W. slope.

54.70 Draw, drains S.; asc. 130 ft. over a broken SE. slope.

65.20 Spur, slopes S.; desc. 140 ft. over a SW. slope.

77.45 The cor. of secs. 19, 24, 25 and 30 on the W. bdy. of the Tp., monumented with an iron post, 3 ins. diam., set, mkd. and witnessed as described in the field notes of the survey of T. 20 N., R. 47 E.

Land, high rolling.

Soil, stony.

Undergrowth, sagebrush and cheat grass.
