	Continue over rolling land.
56.00	Trail road in draw, drains W.
79.96	The cor. of secs. 3, 4, 33 and 34, on the N. bdy. of the Tp., monumented with an iron post, 2½ ins. diam., firmly set, mkd. and witnessed as described in the dependent resurvey of the S. bdy., T. 13 N., R. 64 E., executed concurrently under this same group. Land, rolling. Soil, sandy and gravelly clay loam. Timber, pinon and juniper. Undergrowth, sagebrush.
	From the cor. of secs. 4, 5, 32 and 33, on the S. bdy. of the Tp. NORTH, bet. secs. 32 and 33.
39.50	Fence, bears NNW. and SSE.; enter crested wheat grass pasture.
40.20	Point for the ¼ sec. cor. of secs. 32 and 33, at proportionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner. Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd. <div style="text-align: center;"> T12N R64E ¼ S 32 S 33 1965 </div>
	raise a mound of stone, 3½ ft. base, 2½ ft. high, W. of cor.
50.00	Road, semi-improved, bears NW. and SE.
67.00	Wash, 50 lks. wide, 10 ft. deep, drains NW.
75.00	Fence, bears SE. and NW.; leave crested wheat grass pasture and enter scattering undergrowth; asc. 90 ft. over a WSW. slope.
77.50	Trail road, bears NW. and SE.
80.40	Point for the cor. of secs. 28, 29, 32 and 33, at proportionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner. Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.
