53.00	Fence, barbed wire, bears NE. and SW. Leave reseeded area.	
80.70	The cor. of secs. 3, 4, 9 and 10. Land, level. Soil, sandy, clay and gravel. Undergrowth, crested wheat and sagebrush.	
40.40	N. 0° 18' E., bet. secs. 3 and 4. Over nearly level land, through medium undergrowth. Point for the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of secs. 3 and 4, at proportionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner. Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, $2\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., 22 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd. T13N R64E $\frac{1}{4}$ S 4 S 3 1964 raise a mound of stone, 3 ft. base, $2\frac{1}{2}$ ft. high, W. of cor.	
80.80	The cor. of secs. 3, 4, 33 and 34, Tps. 13 and 14 N., R. 64 E., monumented with an iron post, $2\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., set, mkd. and witnessed as described in the field notes of the concurrent resurvey of T. 14 N., R. 64 E. Land, level. Soil, sandy, clay and gravel. Undergrowth, sagebrush and greasewood.	
6.50	From the cor. of secs. 4, 5, 32 and 33, on the S. bdy. of the Tp. N. 0° 11' W., bet. secs. 32 and 33. Over nearly level land, through medium undergrowth.	
40.30	Enter reseeded area.	
40.30	Point for the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of secs. 32 and 33, at proportionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner. Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, $2\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., 20 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd. T13N R64E $\frac{1}{4}$ S 32 S 33 1964
