Re-establishment of the Survey Executed by
Monroe and Bateman, Deputy Surveyors,
in 1872.

From the cor. of Tps. 13 and 14 N., Rs. 64 and 65 E.

N. 89° 53' W., bet. secs. 1 and 36.

Over gently rolling land sloping W., through medium
undergrowth.

- 24.00 Fence, bears N. and S.
- 27.90 Trail road, bears SE. and NW.
- 34.90 Wash, 10 lks. wide, 2 ft. deep, drains NNW.
- 40.24 The $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of secs. 1 and 36, monumented with a
wooden post, 1x1x28 ins., plainly scribed and firmly set.
- At the corner point
- Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., 24 ins. in
the ground, with brass cap mkd.

- 30.20 Trail road, bears NE. and SW.
- 40.15 Point for the cor. of secs. 1, 2, 35 and 36 at propor-
tionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of the
original corner.
- Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., 24 ins. in
the ground, with brass cap mkd.
