79.29	The closing cor. of secs. 6 and 7, T. 40 N., R. 41 E., monumented with an iron post, 2½ ins. diam., set, mkd. and witnessed as described in the field notes of T. 40 N., R. 41 E., executed concurrently under this same group.
80.00	Point for the cor. of secs. 1 and 12. Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 22 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd. <div style="text-align: center;"> T40N R40E R41E S 1 S 6 S 12 1964 </div> raise a mound of stone, 2½ ft. base, 2 ft. high, W. of cor. 35.80	Wash, 10 lks. wide, 2 ft. deep, drains SE.; asc. 50 ft. over SW. slope.
39.29	The W. ¼ sec. cor. of sec. 6, T. 40 N., R. 41 E., monumented with an iron post, 2½ ins. diam., set, mkd. and witnessed as described in the field notes of T. 40 N., R. 41 E., executed concurrently under this same group.
