31.20	Fence, bears NE. and SW.
40.16	Point for the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of secs. 4 and 5, at proportionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner.
	Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, $2\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., 22 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.

79.89	The closing cor. of secs. 4 and 5, monumented with a steel pipe, $1\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., showing 24 ins. above ground, with steel fence post set alongside and is accepted as the best available evidence of the position of the original corner. This cor. will function as an amended monument and AM is stamped on the steel pipe.
