

DEPENDENT RESURVEY, N. BDY., T. 39 N., R. 41 E.

CHAINS

Reestablishment of the survey executed by
H. B. Maxson, Deputy Surveyor, in 1888.

Beginning at the cor. of Tps. 39 and 40 N., Rs. 41 and 42 E., monumented with an iron post, 2½ ins. diam., set, mkd. and witnessed as described in the field notes of the concurrent resurvey of T. 39 N., R. 42 E., executed under this same group.

N. 89° 08' W., along the N. bdy. of sec. 1.

Over nearly level land, through medium undergrowth.

40.03 The ¼ sec. cor. of sec. 36, T. 40 N., R. 41 E., hereinafter described.

41.61 The ¼ sec. cor. of sec. 1, monumented with a wooden post, 2x4x40 ins., scribed and firmly set in fence, bearing N. 88° E. and N. 88° W.

At the corner point

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground and in a collar of stone, with brass cap mkd.

Over nearly level land, along fence.

38.46 The closing cor. of secs. 35 and 36, T. 40 N., R. 41 E., hereinafter described.

40.28 Point for the cor. of secs. 1 and 2, at proportionate distance and in fence, bearing S. 88° E. and N. 88° W.; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner.

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground and in a collar of stone, with brass cap mkd.
