raise a mound of stone, 2½ ft. base, 2 ft. high, S. of cor.

76.36 The closing cor. of secs. 31 and 32, T. 40 N., R. 41 N., hereinafter described.

Desc. 30 ft. over W. slope.

80.80 The cor. of secs. 5 and 6, monumented with a wooden post, 4x4x40 ins., scribed and firmly set alongside steel fence post, in ravine, draining S.

At the corner point

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground and in a collar of stone, with brass cap mkd.
