

DEPENDENT RESURVEY, N. BDY., T. 40 N., R. 41 E.

CHAINS

Asc. 180 ft. over E. slope.

56.60 Ridge, bears N. and S.; desc. 50 ft. over W. slope.

74.30 Wash, 10 lks. wide, 1 ft. deep, drains S.

77.65 The cor. of Tps. 39 and 40 N., R. 41 E., 3 lks. N. of fence, bearing E. and W., monumented with a wooden post, 4x4x40 ins. scribed and firmly set alongside steel fence post.

At the corner point

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.

Over nearly level land, through medium undergrowth.

32.50 Wash, 10 lks. wide, 2 ft. deep, drains NW.

40.00 Point for the ¼ sec. cor. of secs. 25 and 36.

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 22 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.
