CHAINS

raise a mound of stone, 2 ft. base, 2 ft. high, W. of cor.

78.04 Intersect the N. bdy. of T. 39 N., R. 41 E.

Point for the closing cor. of secs. 35 and 36.

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 22 ins. in the ground and in a collar of stone, with brass cap mkd.

Land, nearly level.

Soil, sandy loam.

The point for the S. ¼ sec. cor. of sec. 36 is on the N. bdy. of T. 39 N., R. 41 E. and at midpoint on the S. bdy. of sec. 36.
