The standard ½ sec. cor. of sec. 34, T. 41 N., R. 41 E., monumented with an iron post, 2½ ins. diam., set, mkd. and witnessed as described in the field notes of the concurrent resurvey of the Eighth Standard Parallel North, through R. 41 E., bears N. 89° 49' W., 12.66 chs. dist.

The standard cor. of secs. 34 and 35, T. 41 N., R. 41 E., monumented with an iron post, 2½ ins. diam., set, mkd. and witnessed as described in the field notes of the concurrent resurvey of the Eighth Standard Parallel North, through R. 41 E., bears S. 89° 49' E., 27.62 chs. dist.

Land, gently rolling.
Soil, sandy loam and gravel.
Undergrowth, sagebrush.

The point for the N. ½ sec. cor. of sec. 2 is on the Eighth Standard Parallel North and at midpoint on the N. bdy. of sec. 2.

At the corner point
