

SUBDIVISION OF T. 40 N., R. 41 E.

CHAINS

58.20 Wash, 20 lks. wide, 2 ft. deep, drains N. 80° E.

67.50 Trail road, bears NE. and SW.

70.85 Fence, bears N. 89° W. and S. 89° E.

71.70 Intersect the N. bdy. of T. 39 N., R. 41 E.

Point for the closing cor. of secs. 32 and 33.

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 22 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.

Land, rolling.

Soil, sandy loam.

Undergrowth, sagebrush, shadscale and budsage.

The point for the S. ¼ sec. cor. of sec. 33 is on the N. bdy of T. 39 N., R. 41 E. and at midpoint on the S. bdy. of sec. 33.
