

## SUBDIVISION OF T. 40 N., R. 41 E.

## CHAINS

Over gently rolling land, through medium undergrowth.

23.40 Wash, 10 lks. wide, 1 ft. deep, drains E.

40.00 Point for the  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor. of secs. 31 and 32.

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long,  $2\frac{1}{2}$  ins. diam., 22 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.

Point for the closing cor. of secs. 31 and 32.

The  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor. of sec. 5, T. 39 N., R. 41 E., heretofore described, bears S.  $88^\circ 33'$  E., 35.96 chs. dist.

Land, gently rolling.

Soil, sandy loam and rocky.

Undergrowth, sagebrush, shadscale and budsage.

The point for the S.  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor. of sec. 32 is on the N. bdy. of T. 39 N., R. 41 E. and at midpoint on the S. bdy. of sec. 32.

At the corner point

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long,  $2\frac{1}{2}$  ins. diam., 22 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.
