Over low mountainous land, through medium undergrowth; asc. 20 ft. over a SE. slope.

3.00 Ridge, bears NE. and SW.; desc. 390 ft. over a steep NW. slope.

23.00 Ravine, drains NW.; desc. 110 ft. over a NW. slope.
