	<p>Over rolling land, through medium undergrowth; asc. 140 ft. over a gentle S. slope.</p>
1.50	<p>Rock outcropping, 12 ft. base, 8 ft. high, bears E., 40 lks. dist.</p>
25.00	<p>Spur, slopes SE.; continue over rolling land.</p>
31.30	<p>Ravine, drains S. 70° E.</p>
39.525	<p>Point for the ¼ sec. cor. of secs. 31 and 36, at proportionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner.</p> <p>Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 14 ins. in the ground to bedrock and in a mound of stone to cap, 3½ ft. base, with brass cap mkd.</p>

75.20	<p>Wash, 10 lks. wide, 2 ft. deep, drains S. 60° E.; asc. 60 ft. over a SW. slope.</p>
79.05	<p>Point for the cor. of secs. 25, 30, 31 and 36, at proportionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner.</p> <p>Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 4 ins. in the ground to bedrock and in a mound of stone to cap, 4 ft. base, with brass cap mkd.</p>
