Reestablishment of the Survey Executed by Epler,
Deputy Surveyor, in 1867

Note: All corners north of the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of secs. 25 and 30 to the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of secs. 1 and 6 were monumented and marked for T. 42 N., R. 41 E., only.

Beginning at the cor. of Tps. 41 and 42 N., Rs. 40 and 41 E., an iron post, $2\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., set, mkd. and witnessed as described in the field notes of the concurrent resurvey of T. 41 N., R. 41 E.

N. $0^{\circ} 04'$ E., bet. secs. 31 and 36.

Over rolling land, through medium undergrowth.

20.10 Point for the S. $\frac{1}{16}$ sec. cor. of secs. 31 and 36, at midpoint.

Set an iron post, 36 ins. long, 1 in. diam., 30 ins. in the ground with brass cap mkd.

22.22 Fence, bears S. $87^{\circ} 08'$ W. and N. $87^{\circ} 08'$ E.

40.20 The $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of secs. 31 and 36, monumented with a lava stone, $14 \times 8 \times 4$ ins., firmly set and plainly mkd. $\frac{1}{4}$ on the N. face, with a steel fence post alongside.

At the corner point

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, $2\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., 22 ins. in the ground with brass cap mkd.
