S. 89° 41' W., beginning new measurement.

- 0.30 Bluff, 20 ft. high; desc. 200 ft. over a NW. slope.
- 14.10 Trail road, bears SW. and NE.
- 16.20 Wash, 10 lks, wide, 3 ft. deep, drains S. 70° E.; asc. 170 ft. over a SE. slope.
- 38.80 The cor. of Tps. 42 and 43 N., Rs. 40 and 41 E.

Land, rolling mountainous.
Soil, sandy loam.
Undergrowth, sagebrush.

Re-establishment of the Survey Executed by Fisher
and Morrison, Deputy Surveyors, in 1882.

From the cor. of secs. 1, 2, 35, and 36 on the S. bdy. of
the Tp., an iron post 2½ ins. diam., set, mkd. and
witnessed as described in the field notes of the concur-
rent resurvey of T. 41 N., R. 41 E.

N. 1° 24' W., bet. secs. 35 and 36.

Over rolling mountainous land, through medium undergrowth;
asc. 30 ft. over a S. slope.

- 5.40 Top of ascent on E. slope of ridge; desc. 90 ft. over a
NE. slope.
- 39.60 Ravine, drains SE.
- 39.73 Point for the ¼ sec. cor. of secs. 35 and 36, at propor-
tionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of the
original corner.

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 6 ins. in
the ground to bedrock and in a mound of stone to cap, 4½
ft. base, with brass cap mkd.
