79.24	The cor. of secs. 2, 3, 10 and 11.
	Land, rolling. Soil, sandy clay loam and rocky. Undergrowth, sagebrush.
	N. 4° 41' E., bet. secs. 2 and 3.
	Over rolling land, draining W., through medium undergrowth.
0.80	Wash, 10 lks. wide, 1 ft. deep, drains W.
28.00	Wash, 10 lks. wide, 2 ft. deep, drains N. 75° W.
29.10	Wash, 20 lks. wide, 2 ft. deep, drains S. 75° W.
41.09	Point for the ¼ sec. cor. of secs. 2 and 3, at proportionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner.
	Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 22 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.

	Land, rolling. Soil, sandy clay loam and rocky. Undergrowth, sagebrush, shadscale and budsage.
	From the cor. of secs. 3, 4, 33 and 34 on the S. bdy. of the Tp., monumented with an iron post, 2½ ins. diam., set, mkd. and witnessed as described in the field notes of the resurvey of T. 38 N., R. 42 E., under Group No. 411.
	N. 1° 25' E., bet. secs. 33 and 34.
