The standard $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of sec. 31, bears S. $89^{\circ} 46'$ W., 11.90 chs. dist.

The standard cor. of secs. 31 and 32, bears N. $89^{\circ} 46'$ E., 28.91 chs. dist.

Land, gently rolling.

Soil, sandy loam and gravelly.

Undergrowth, sagebrush, shadscale and budsage.

The point for the N. $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of sec. 6 is on the Eighth Standard Parallel N. and at midpoint in departure on the N. bdy. of sec. 6.

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, $2\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., 22 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.

From the cor. of secs. 32 and 33 on the S. bdy. of the Tp., monumented with an iron post, $2\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., set, mkd. and witnessed as described in the field notes of the concurrent resurvey of T. 39 N., R. 42 E.

N. $0^{\circ} 02'$ E., bet. secs. 32 and 33.

Over gently rolling land, draining NW., through medium undergrowth.
