raise a mound of stone, 2 ft. base, 2 ft. high, W. of cor.

46.90 Wash, 20 lks. wide, 1 ft. deep, drains SW.

78.08 Intersect the Eighth Standard Parallel North.

Point for the closing cor. of secs. 3 and 4.

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 22 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.

The standard cor. of secs. 33 and 34, bears S. 88° 23' E., 29.89 chs. dist.

Land, gently rolling.

Soil, sandy loam and gravelly.

Undergrowth, shadscale and budsage.

The point for the N. ¼ sec. cor. of sec. 4 is on the Eighth Standard Parallel N. and at midpoint in departure on the N. bdy. of sec. 4.

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 22 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.

From the cor. of secs. 34 and 35 on the S. bdy. of the Tp., monumented with an iron post, 2½ ins. diam., set, mkd. and witnessed as described in the field notes of the concurrent resurvey of T. 39 N., R. 42 E.
