CHAINS

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, $2\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., 22 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.

The standard $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of sec. 34, bears N. 89° 33' W., 9.63 chs. dist.

The standard cor. of secs. 34 and 35, bears S. 89° 33' E., 30.55 chs. dist.

Land, gently rolling.

Soil, sandy loam.

Undergrowth, sagebrush and shadscale.

The point for the N. $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of sec. 3 is on the Eighth Standard Parallel N. and at midpoint in departure on the N. bdy. of sec. 3.

The standard $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of sec. 34, bears S. 87° 14' E., 30.43 chs. dist.

From the cor. of secs. 35 and 36 on the S. bdy. of the Tp., monumented with an iron post, $2\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., set, mkd. and witnessed as described in the field notes of the concurrent resurvey of T. 39 N., R. 42 E.

N. $0^\circ 04'$ E., bet. secs. 35 and 36.

Over low mountainous land, through medium undergrowth; asc. 80 ft. over a S. slope.
