	<p>GENERAL DESCRIPTION</p>	
	<p>The land within Township 39 North, Range 43 East is gently rolling to rolling desert land. The soil varies from sandy loam on the gently rolling land to sandy clay loam on the rolling land. The vegetation consists of sagebrush, shadscale, budsage, greasewood and sparse native grasses.</p>	
	<p>The township is drained southerly by Kelly Creek and Rabbit Creek (dry). The Kelly Creek Ranch house is located in section 14. The water from Kelly Creek is used for irrigation of meadow land in sections 11, 14, 22, 23 and 27. There is a spring in section 24. A well is located in section 6.</p>	
	<p>Principal users of the area are cattlemen and access into the township is provided by unimproved and improved desert roads. No mineral formations of consequence were noted during the survey.</p>
